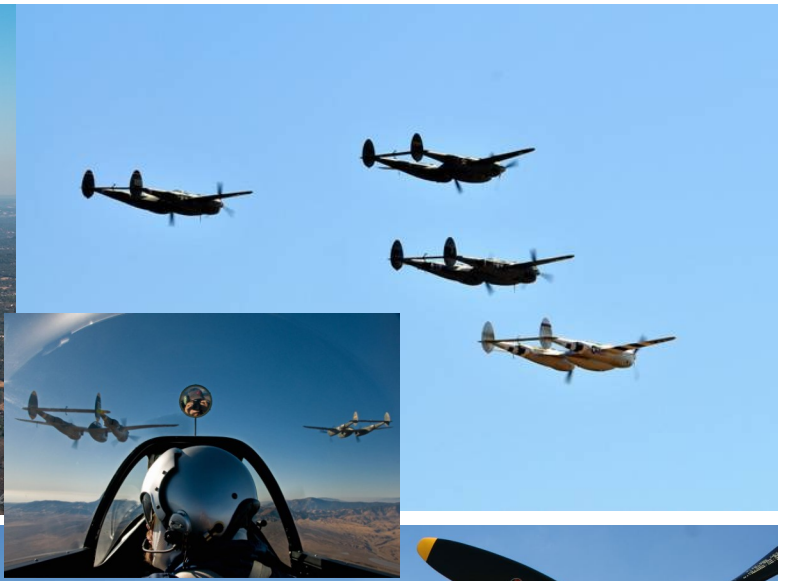

P-38s at the Capitol Air Show

Sept. 10th: five of the seven flying P-38s left from Chino headed for the Sacramento Capital air show at Mather AFB for the weekend. John Maloney flew chase in a P-51...first joining up over Lake Mathews for a quick and dirty photo shoot, then climbed up and headed north. Along the way (Steve) Hinton decided we would buzz Shafter where his son was preparing "Strega" for Reno..So we went whistling by their hangar, line a breast at about 300 and pulled and came around single ship....climbed back up and joined up. 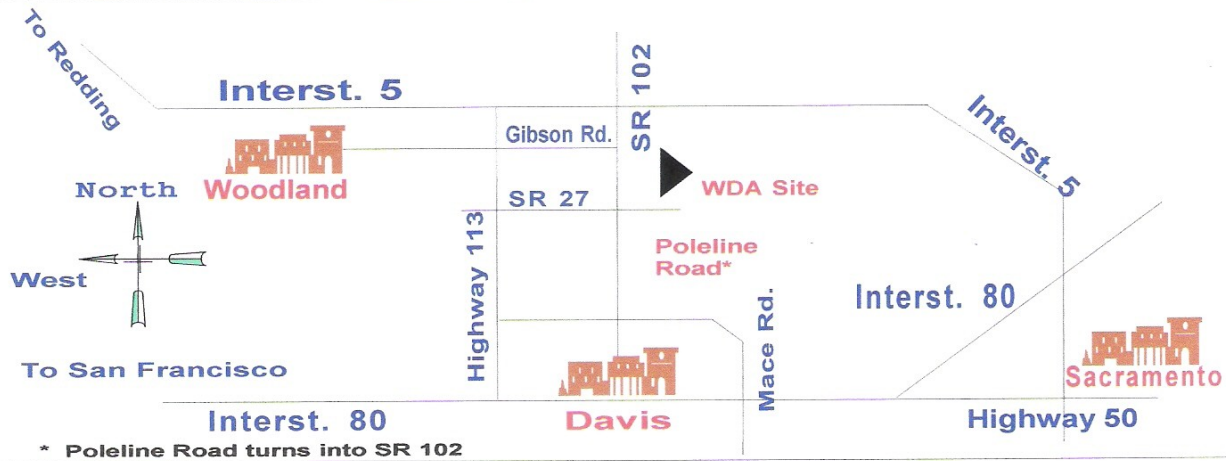
